Information Leaflet PQ02

Please be aware that on 16:9 televisions, viewers may notice a 'band shadow' either side of the tube, approximately where the 4:3 picture would normally end. This is purely extra support required for the shadow mask inside the tube to stop doming (purity problems). This is a feature in all wide screen tube manufacture, and should not affect your viewing quality. In most cases this can only be seen on certain picture content e.g. (on a football match when most of the screen is green, a slight change in shade of green may be seen on the outer edge of the picture.)

This effect is recognised by all manufacturers of Widescreen televisions and is not generally classified as being a fault. Some manufacturers may give you a different explanation as to why their tubes have this effect.
